

ORDINANCE NO. O-096-2011

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH
COUNCIL PROVIDING FOR REDISTRICTING OF CITY-PARISH COUNCIL
DISTRICTS AND THE ADOPTION OF NEW CITY-PARISH COUNCIL DISTRICTS
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2010 FEDERAL CENSUS BY THE UNITED STATES
BUREAU OF THE CENSUS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, Section 2-01 of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter provides, in pertinent part, that there shall be nine (9) Council Districts, which Council Districts are to continue until such time as they are changed by redistricting in accordance with applicable law, including Section 2-02 of the Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 Federal Census has now been performed and the information reported in said Census has revealed the need to redistrict the Council Districts in accordance with all applicable provisions of law; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Council, pursuant to and in accordance with the 2010 Federal Census, wishes to redistrict and establish new City-Parish Council Districts with new territorial limits and boundaries and to designate said Council Districts in accordance with its redistricting plan; and

WHEREAS, six (6) proposed plans of redistricting, and variations thereof, have been made by the demographer jointly retained and engaged by the Lafayette City-Parish Council and the Lafayette Parish School Board and those six (6) proposed plans, and variations thereof, have been submitted to the Lafayette City-Parish Council for its review and consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City-Parish Council does hereby adopt "LCG-LPSB Draft Plan 5b-1 Districts," as attached hereto, and made a part hereof, as Exhibit 5b-1-A (map), Exhibit 5b-1-B (statistical information on population by race, on the 18+ population by race, and registered voters by race) and Exhibit 5b-1-C (the voting districts/precincts in each Council District) as its Council Districts such that the nine (9) City-Parish Council Districts, as redistricted, shall be those Council Districts depicted in such Plan of Redistricting.

SECTION 3: Ordinance No. O-095-2011 that splits a certain existing Precinct, and describes the boundaries of such Precincts so created, necessary for the formation of the new City-Parish Council Districts delineated in the Plan of Redistricting adopted hereby, was adopted by the Lafayette City-Parish Council currently with the adoption of this Ordinance. It is the intent

that this Ordinance be adopted in conjunction with Ordinance No. O-095-2011 inasmuch as the split of the Precinct effectuated therein forms the boundaries necessary for the new City-Parish Council Districts delineated in the Plan of Redistricting adopted hereby and, thus, Ordinance No. O-095-2011 is incorporated herein, by reference thereto.

SECTION 4: The Lafayette City-Parish Attorney, in coordination with the contracted demographer, is hereby authorized and empowered to submit and file all papers or other documents including, but not limited to, this Ordinance with Exhibits and Ordinance No. O-095-2011 with the United States Department of Justice seeking preclearance under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C.A. § 1973, *et seq.*, as amended, of the Plan of Redistricting adopted hereby and the Precinct split adopted by Ordinance No. O-095-2011, and to take any and all other action necessary in connection therewith.

SECTION 5: The Lafayette City-Parish Attorney, in coordination with the contracted demographer, is also hereby further authorized to file and send all papers or other documents including, but not limited to, a certified copy of this Ordinance with Exhibits and Ordinance No. O-095-2011 to all necessary State and local Officials, including but not limited to, the Secretary of State, the Secretary of the Senate, The Clerk of the House of Representatives, the Clerk of Court of Lafayette Parish, and/or the Registrar of Voters of Lafayette Parish, pursuant to any applicable provisions of law, and take any and all other action necessary in connection therewith.

SECTION 6: Each of the nine (9) new Council Districts herein adopted shall be represented by a City-Parish Council Member elected from his or her respective new Council District.

SECTION 7: All Ordinances and/or Resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8: In accordance with the provisions of Section 2-13D of the Home Rule Charter, this Ordinance is not subject to the veto power of the Lafayette City-Parish President and, accordingly, is effective upon signature of the Lafayette City-Parish President, or the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette City-Parish President without signature, whichever occurs first, but subject to preclearance by the United States Department of Justice under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C.A. § 1973, *et seq.*, as amended, of the Plan of Redistricting adopted hereby and the Precinct split adopted by Ordinance No. O-095-2011, and other applicable Louisiana law.

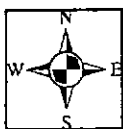
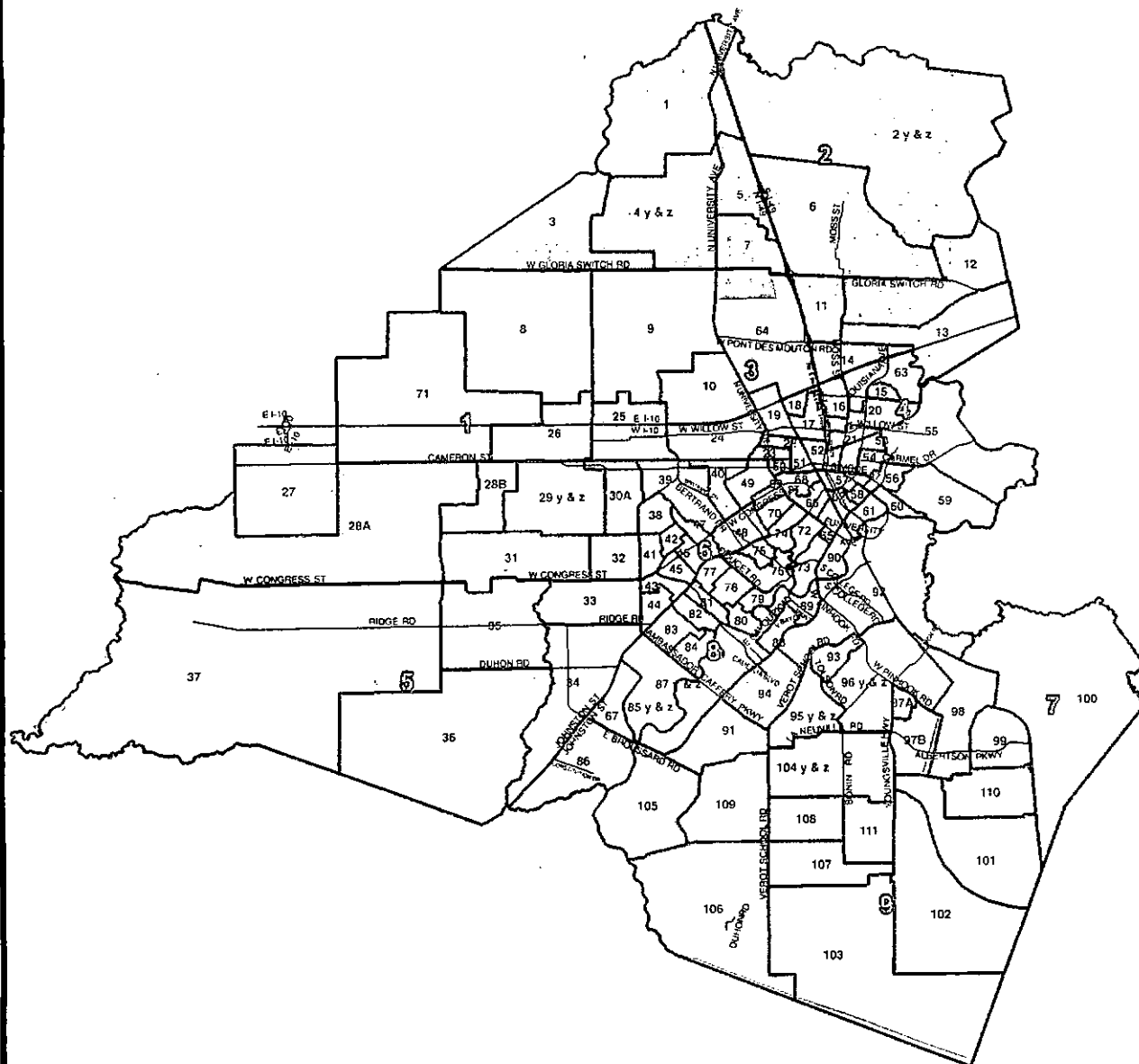
